**Location:** Vista Flores, Tunuyán, Mendoza

**Winemaker:** José Hernández Toso

**Composition:** 65% Bonarda - 35% Petit Verdot

**Altitude:** 1100 m.a.s.l.

**Soil:** Alluvial origin, Sandy-loam texture interwoven with boulders. They are poor in organic matter and have excellent drainage.

**Aging:** 14 months in French oak barrels

**Cellaring potential:** 15 years

## Tasting notes:

A bold and vibrant blend, deep purple in color. The exuberance of Petit Verdot reveals flavors of black cherry, sage and plum. Bonarda brings freshness and a balanced acidity. The blend of both varieties creates an elegant wine, with great aromatic potential. Its aging of 14 months gives it a velvety and persistent end of great character.
